### ▶ TEAM LEADER

Each team will have a Team Leader that will attend workshops and events in the fall. In the spring, Team Leaders will direct their team toward developing and pitching a possible solution.

- ▶ \$2,500 Scholarship
- ▶ Applications due Sept. 15, 2023

### ▶ GROUP OR STUDENT ORGANIZATION

Each organization must nominate one Team Leader. Teams must have at least two and no more than four members.

- ▶ \$1,000 Scholarship
- ▶ Team Leader due Sept. 15, 2023
- ▶ Register team by Jan. 15, 2024

### ▶ TEAM PARTICIPANT

P2P coordinators will work with each participant to place them on a team that best suits their interests.

- ▶ \$1,000 Scholarship
- ▶ Registration due Jan. 15, 2024
